Affidavit of Kenneth Caddick

Kenneth Caddick, under penalty of perjury, does hereby declare as follows:

1. In 1983 I met Chicago police officer Jon Burge in Popolanos Restaurant in Lansing, Illinois.
2. Subsequently that year, while at Popolanos, I saw Jon Burge and asked him how it was going.
3. Burge, who seemed ticked off, replied that he had been "dealing with dead fucking niggers all day."
4. On another occasion, I was sitting at the bar at Popolanos with Burge and a report about the Wilson brothers case came on the 5 o'clock news.
5. The bartender, April Hagan, who was dating Burge at the time, turned to Burge and said "Jon, tell them how you got the confession."
6. She was laughing and moving her hand in a cranking motion.
7. Burge's face turned beet red, and he moved his hand in an up and down motion, signaling her to keep her mouth shut.

8. On another occasion at Popolanos, Burge talked about how the handcuff rings at the new Area 2 police station were too high, and how they would handcuff suspects to the rings anyway, and leave them there for a couple of hours until they started hollering.
9. I also had conversations with April Hagan, who told me that she had learned from Burge that the Wilson brothers were tortured, that Burge used a black box to question suspects, that the box was used to electroshock suspects, and that Burge learned these tactics while serving in Viet Nam.

I, Kenneth Caddick, do hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
